#### IDAHO FFA ASSOCIATION CODE OF CONDUCT AND CONTRACT FOR DISTRICT OFFICERS

As a District Officer of the Idaho FFA Association of the National FFA Organization, I realize that I will be representing all FFA members of Idaho and that my conduct is a model for all members. While I am a District Officer, I will be meeting with local chapters and individual members; School Administrators; Industry Representatives; Community, State and National Government Officials and other Friends of FFA. I know that I will be a Key Person at the Statewide Events for FFA. I am aware that I will have extra responsibilities as a District Officer, and I agree to adopt the following rules and regulations as the standards for my personal behavior throughout my term of office.

- 1. I will at all times respect all public and private property.
- 2. I will spend each night in the room of the hotel/motel to which I am assigned.
- 3. I will strictly abide by the curfew established, retire to my assigned room (unless on special assignment by the State Officer Coordinator), and I will respect the rights of others by being as quiet as possible after curfew.
- 4. I will not remain in a sleeping room of the opposite sex unless the door is completely open at all times.
- 5. I will refrain from the use of tobacco, alcoholic beverages and drugs.
- 6. I will demonstrate moral behavior in my personal and social life.
- 7. I will not leave the hotel/motel to which I am assigned without informing the State Officer Coordinator or Designated Assistant.
- 8. I will keep the State Officer Coordinator or Designated Assistant informed of my whereabouts at all times.
- 9. I will attend ALL General Sessions and other activities for which I am assigned, and registered and I will be on time.
- 10. I will adhere to the dress code at all times as required.
- 11. I will maintain grades that are average or higher (C or 2.0 GPA) and should I fail to do this, I will consult with my Instructor/Advisor and make a plan to correct the situation. I will show improvement by the end of the next full grading period, and make a written report to the Executive Council/FFA Board of Directors.
- 12. I will attend school each day it is in session unless I am at a school sponsored event or ill. I am responsible for the make up all work in the classes I miss.
- 13. I will respect all authority.
- 14. I will fulfill the responsibilities of my office, and meet my obligations to FFA members throughout the state.
- 15. I will take adequate time to prepare for all meetings and activities.
- 16. I will model the ideals of the FFA throughout my term of office.

I agree that if, for any reason, I am in violation of any of the terms of this Contract, I may be held accountable to the State FFA Advisor and/or a Committee of the Idaho FFA Board of Directors appointed by the State FFA Advisor to review alleged violations. I recognize the authority of the Idaho FFA Board of Directors to assess penalties for violations of the terms of this agreement. I further agree to accept penalties assessed for my actions pending my right of appeal to the full Idaho FFA Board of Directors whose decisions in such matters shall be final.

- 1. Violations of Items 1 thru 6 of the "District Officers Contract" will be grounds for disqualification and immediate removal from office and relinquishment of awards and recognition. Notification of the violation and action taken will be sent to the State Division of Vocational Education, the local School Administration and the Parents/Guardians.
- 2. Violations of Items 7 thru 13 of the "District Officer's Contract" will result in a warning and a reprimand. Repeated violations of items 7 thru 13 may result in the participant being asked to resign from Office. Notification of the violation and action taken will be sent to the State Division of Vocational Education at the discretion of the Disciplinary Committee.
